Kitipong Promwong completed his B.Sc. in Biochemistry from Chulalongkorn University in Bangkok in 1994. He received his M.Sc. in Science and Technology Policy and Ph.D. in Development Studies at the University of Strathclyde in Glasgow in 1996 and 2001 respectively.

He is working at the National Science Technology and Innovation Policy Office (STI) with the position of Director of Policy Research and Management Department. His main responsibility includes directing policy research and formulation related to science, technology and innovation and supervising secretariat works for the National Science Technology and Innovation Policy Committee and subcommittees under it.

Kitipong has been actively involving in formulating science, technology and innovation policy and strategy at the national level. He was a key member of the task group in charge of drafting several national technology-related plans including the National S&T Strategic Plan (2004 - 2013), the National Nanotechnology Master Plan (2004 - 2013) and S&T Manpower Development Roadmap (2005 – 2013). He also engaged in the government project concerning restructuring of the national R&D system, as a member of the core team. In addition, he played significant role in the enactment of the 2008 National STI Act –which is Thailand basic law on science, technology and innovation – and setting up the National Science Technology and Innovation Policy Office (STI).

Kitipong also has significant contribution to higher education. He has been co-supervisor of postgraduate students of Sukhothai Thammathirat Open University (STOU). He participated in writing up a textbook for STOU. Moreover, he was an instructor in a Doctoral course (Science and Technology Policy and Management) at Rajabhat University Phranakhon and a Master course in Technology and Innovation Management at the Management College, Mahidol University and at the College of Innovation, Thammasart University. He has been a regularly-invited lecturer of a number of higher educational institutes including e.g. Senior Air Officer College (under the Royal Thai Air Force), Commandant of Security School (under the Royal Thai Armed Forces Headquarters) and the Local Personnel Development Institution (under the Department of Local Administration).
